#### The Region of Emilia Romagna





- 4 million people
- 7,500+ co-ops (2/3 are worker co-ops)
- 30-40% of GDP
- 2 out 3 are members of co-ops
- 10% employed by co-ops
- Cross-sector collaboration
- "Full employment"
- High standard of living

#### 3elle Imola





- Founded in 1908
- Employment for art students
- 306 employees, 156 members
- Manufacturer & exporter of windows & doors
- ◆ €69 million in sales (\$98.8 mill)
- €69 million in net assets
- Interco-operation

# Giovani Relagatori Social Co-op





- Founded in 1983
- Employment & training for marginalized individuals
- Bookbinding, printing, small parts assembly & archiving
- 25 permanent employees
- €1.25 (\$1.79) million in sales
- Key loan from Legacoop
- 60% of customers are co-ops

#### Coopfond Bologna



- "External mutuality"
- Lending & equity
- Technical assistance
- Cross-sector role
- Funded by co-ops through contribution of 3% of surplus

- Cross-sector federation
- Coordination, Advocacy, Training, Funding
- Growth 1982 2007
  - 52 co-ops 84 co-ops
  - 18,336 members 65,604 (258%)
  - 2,910 direct employees 6,863 (136%)
  - €164,743 revenue €2.4 billion (1,365%)
